**Your Servant I’LL Always Be**

Pierce My Ear, Oh Lord, my God

In Bible times, a servant had to serve his master for six years, after which he was free to leave. If the servant had a good master and if he loved his master, he could decide to stay with his master forever, and the servant would then pierce his ear as an outward symbol of his inward devotion, as demonstrated in Exodus 21:2-6

Imagine how wonderful this world would be if everyone had their hearts pierced for Christ the way we are told to in Matthew 22:37: “You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.” We may not be able to change the world, but we can let the *Word* change us!
