Rise and shine. That is what the sun does each morning. That is its function with the coming of each new day. That is its purpose as designed by the Creator.

As Paul exhorted those at Rome that grace was not to be viewed as an open door for continuing in sin, but rather a reason to cease to sin, he drew attention to the meaning of their baptism into Christ. We read. . .

“(3) Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? (4) We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just AS CHRIST WAS RAISED from the dead by the glory of the Father, WE TOO MIGHT WALK IN NEWNESS OF LIFE.”
(Romans 6:3-4 ESV)

Baptism parallels our Lord's death, burial, and resurrection. As Jesus surrendered to the cross and death which followed, we too are to surrender to being baptized. Through baptism we are brought into connection with the power of Jesus' blood to wash away our sins. It is a picture of dying to sin and self, being buried, and then RISING TO LIVE A NEW LIFE. Therefore our focus is not to be. There is the LIVING OF A NEW LIFE that is to follow; a life in line with the Will of God, revealing a genuine appreciation for His grace.

Because of our new relationship with THE SON, we can RISE AND SHINE as the lights of which this world is in need.(Matthew 5:14-16) That is the purpose of our life as designed by theCreator and Renewer of our life.
