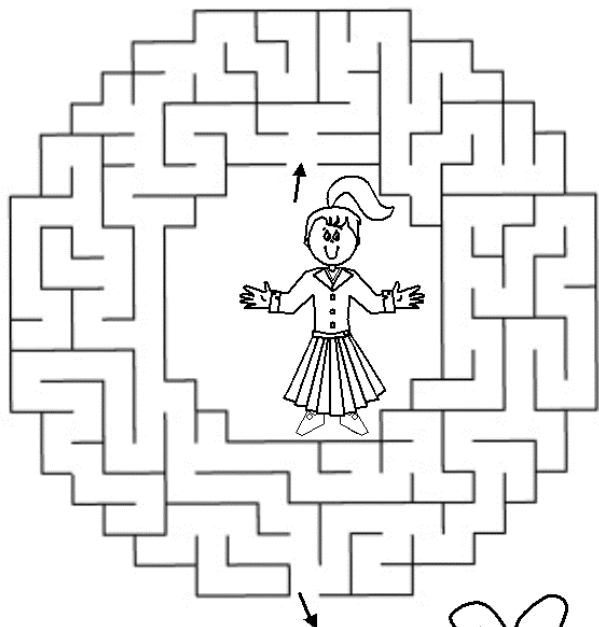


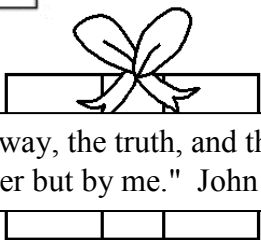

### **Congregational Meeting and Future Events**

The Elders are thankful for those who stayed to learn about the work of the Church in 2012. Many things were discussed and future plans for the New Year were presented by the Elders.

The Budget for 2012 has been set at \$903.00 per week. These funds given for the Lord will allow us to carry out the work of the Church here, as well as other places around the world. We would like to thank you for your steadfast giving and encourage you to maintain what you have purposed for the Lord each week.

We will continue with the programs we have had for several years: fair booth, clothing give-away day, youth activities, food pantry, clothing room, and sending kids to camp.

**On April 22**, Lowell Huffman, President of Camp Indogan, will be here to present the Camp Indogan work. This is in direct response to a crisis that Camp Indogan is now experiencing due to state regulations. More space needs to be created to maintain our current camper levels. The Board of Directors is asking for \$25,000 so additions can be added. So on Sunday, April 22, Lowell will present the Camp’s needs. We have committed \$1000 to the cause and the entire contribution on April 22 will be given in addition to the \$1000. So, if you desire to give more than your usual offering that day, we encourage you to do so. The goal is to give at least \$1000 that Sunday to reach the goal of giving \$2000 total to Camp Indogan which will be presented to Lowell on that day.

**March 24-25, 2013 Steve Diggs** will be here to host the seminar “**No Debt, No Sweat**”. It is a two day seminar on Godly Money Management. This is a ministry of the Antioch Church of Christ in Tennessee. The Elders believe this will be an excellent outreach in our community as well as for the congregation. We are excited about this outreach even though it is little more than a year away. Everyone can be and should be involved in making this seminar a great success of reaching out to people. Last year you gave so a water well could be drilled in Ghana (over \$8,000). This year we will participate in making sure Camp Indogan will not have to turn campers away (\$2000), and next year we will provide a free service to the community with a final seminar (\$3,000).
