Pray and Obey

Fifteen years ago an older Christian friend shared with man a statement from a sermon still lodged in his heart from several years before. The preacher had said, "The Christian life can be summed up in three words "Pray and obey." The man didn't know why, but those simple words have stuck in his own heart over the years. Christians are people who are seeking not only to learn God's will but also to align themselves with God's will and live it out in a world that is radically self-willed. "Not My will but Thine" we hear Jesus praying as He wrestled with the will of God in Gethsemane hours before the agony of the cross. Jesus was praying in order to obey.

First John 3:22 reminds us Christians should pray and obey "whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight." It has been said, "Prayer is not a substitute for work, thinking, watching, suffering, or giving; prayer is a support for all other efforts

A preacher once said, "I've been working on my calories prayer and when I get it together, I'm going to pray calories out of food. I haven't quite mastered it yet. . . . As of now, the prayer will work, but you got to jog while you pray." That idea on prayer is not far off the mark. The Good Book teaches God's children to pray and obey!
