Dear Fathers

Some in our society want people to believe that being a Father is overrated and not really that important in the family structure. On the contrary, a father in the home is as equally important as a mother. If anything, fathers and their God-ordained role in the home are underrated in our fractured society. In both the Old and New Testament, it teaches that respect for fathers is to be adhered to and practiced: Ephesians 6:2 and Exodus 20:12.

Fathers, your presence today speaks to your belief that worshiping God is important, and you are sending that message to your children as God would have you do. Grandfathers, in like manner, your presence today is sending the same message.

A father's position in the home is to be taken seriously with the understanding that this placement was not and never has been an afterthought by God that was just thrown into the family structure as an ornament, like a statue of a lion at a gate, but rather, a position that is just as strong and important as the mother. God created a family with three parts: father, mother and children, and no matter how the world attempts to redefine the family, God's structure stands as truth. We who firmly believe must hold on to our position on the importance of fathers with perseverance and love. We must also set an example because it is necessary to the health of our families, the Church and to the nation.

God encouraged Joshua to lead the people of Israel to take the promised land. **Joshua 1:9 "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."** While this charge was given to Joshua, we too are heading to a promised land called Heaven. Let us always be strong and courageous for the Lord is with us as Fathers. Fathers, may God bless you.
