

In 1633, Rembrandt painted the "Raising of the Cross." In this painting, at the foot of the cross is pictured a man wearing a blue painter's beret. That man was Rembrandt himself, included in the painting as the one raising the cross. He took the death of Christ on the cross VERY PERSONALLY. For Rembrandt's own sins, Christ was raised to die.

Paul also took it personally where we read. . .

"(20) I have been crucified with CHRIST. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, WHO LOVED ME AND GAVE HIMSELF FOR ME." ([Galatians 2:20](#))

Paul acknowledged "Jesus LOVED ME." Because of that great love Paul stated Jesus "gave Himself FOR ME." IT WAS PERSONAL. Paul was in the picture, who in spite of viewing himself as having been the foremost or worst of sinners ([1 Timothy 1:15-16](#)), accepted the power of God's grace to deal adequately with the sin in his life. That PERSONAL ACKNOWLEDGEMENT played a powerful role in redirecting and transforming his life. It also compelled him to diligently share the Good News of Jesus with others.

How PERSONALLY do we view Jesus' love and sacrifice? If we refuse to acknowledge our place in the picture we will fail to recognize the seriousness of our sins and the great love Christ has for us in spite of them. He "came into the world to save sinners." ([1 Timothy 1:15](#)) It is my own sins and your own sins that put Him on the cross and because of His love for you and me He willingly endured it all.

Praise God there is more to the picture than just the cross and we can be included in that as well. May we remain within the frame of our Lord's loving provision for now and eternity.
