Scientific Foreknowledge in the Bible

I. Paths of the Sea (Psalm 8:8) ⁸ **the birds of the heavens, and the fish of the sea, whatever passes along the paths of the seas.**

Matthew Fontaine Maury "Pathfinder of the Seas" Born in 1806. Entered U.S. Navy in 1925.

1) "I have been blamed by men of science, both in this country and in England, for quoting the Bible in confirmation of the doctrines of physical geography. The Bible, they say, was not written for scientific purposes, and is therefore no authority in matters of science. I beg pardon! The Bible is authority for everything it touches." Lewis, Charles Lee (1927), Matthew Fontaine Maury: The Pathfinder of the Seas.

The discovery of wind and sea currents through God's Word

II. The Water Cycle (Ecclesiastes 1:7) "All streams run to the sea, but the sea is not full; to the place where the streams flow, there they flow again.

1) This is a basic understanding of what we call "The Water Cycle." Waters from rivers flow into the ocean. The Mississippi dumps 6,052,500 gallons of water per second into the Gulf of Mexico. Yet the sea is not full. The ocean evaporates. Water returns to land in the form of clouds. The water returns to the rivers in the form of precipitation. The idea of a complete water cycle. The idea was not developed until the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries. First proposed by Pierre Perrault and Edme Mariotte.

Circumcision (Genesis 17:12) God commanded circumcision to be on the eighth day. Why not sooner or later?

2. It has been shown medically that the eighth day is when the human body produces the most vitamin K. What does it do? It helps the body form blood clots which is important in surgical procedures. If that vitamin was not present, then the baby would bleed to death. But it is on this day that the level of the vitamin is naturally the highest due to the action of naturally occurring bacteria in the intestinal tract.
