Nehemiah

As Christians we understand the importance of studying God's Word (Hebrews 4:12). We often study books in the Bible that contain practical advice such as Proverbs and James. We also like books which highlight God's love such as John's epistles or the Psalms. Whether you are a new Christian and want to learn more about Jesus or a life-long disciple who wants to dig deeper into His teachings, the gospel accounts (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John) are always popular to peruse. Let me encourage you to explore the wonderful book of Nehemiah. It is a book of faith, teamwork, perseverance, dedication, leadership, renewal, discovery, and countless other traits displayed by God's people.

Read through the book and make the application to where you are in the work of the church today. Does your heart yearn to help those who need it like Nehemiah in Chapter 1? Are you working side-by-side with fellow Christians doing your part like those in Chapter 3? Do you overcome ridicule and discouragement like they did in Chapter 4? Do you finish what you start like the workers in Chapter 6? Do you refresh your mind and spirit by turning to the Word like the gathering of believers did in Chapter 8?

Nehemiah is a wonderful book that shows how God takes ordinary people and accomplishes extraordinary tasks. Take the time to read through the book of Nehemiah. Although we may follow the precepts and promises of the New Testament, Paul reminds us of the value of the ancient scriptures (1 Corinthians 10:11). Prepare yourself (2 Timothy 2:15) to do your part in the Kingdom by exploring this rich book and applying the timeless principles found within.

Nehemiah is a timeless book of principles that tells a true story of a group of people determined to make things right.
