**Be Merciful To Me**

David wrote this Psalm with the memory of being hunted on his mind. He fled from Saul and resorted to hiding out in a cave. The feeling of being hunted! The lack of comfort in hiding out in a cave! The anxiety of waiting in the dark for hours (both physically and metaphorically)! In this eleven-verse Psalm David pens while reflecting upon his experience in the cave, it's no wonder that the first words penned were, "**Be merciful to me, O God, be merciful to me!**" **Psalms 57:1** A shocking line slaps me in the face right after those words - "For my soul trusts in You; And in the shadow of Your wings I will make my refuge."

There you have it - the most freeing, and most difficult act for the human soul- trusting in God's control in trials. Is this not what our life boils down to? In the garden, Eve was tempted by the serpent and finally gave in. She did not trust that God would provide. She wanted knowledge instead of trust. Abraham had his son Ishmael through Hagar instead of waiting on the Lord to provide a son through Sarah. He did not trust that God would provide. He wanted control of his future instead of trust.

The examples are never-ending. Sin comes when we refuse to believe God will give us what we need when we need it. This brings a new appreciation for **Psalm 57:1**. We must trust in God - this means trusting Him to the ultimate conclusion that He WILL provide us with what we need, when we need it. David had quite a situation on his hands. Someone was trying to hunt him down and kill him. All control was stripped away from David he placed all control and trust in God's hand.

I challenge you to place trust in God when you encounter your 'calamities'. When you are tempted to provide for yourself and give in to temptation, I challenge you to be still, wait, and place trust in the Lord to provide you with what you need, when you need it.
